REGULATIONS

1. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION IN TO THE COURSE

A candidate shall be eligible for admission into the ShikshaShastri -B.Ed. course provided:

The candidate passed Shastri / +3 (Arts) / B.A. or any equivalent examination there to from a recognized University/recognized examining body shall be eligible to take admission after qualifying the SSET (Shikshashastri Entrance Test) . Sanskrit as a subject for nontraditional stream i.e. +3 (Arts), B.A. etc. as desired is mandatory. A cut off mark of 50% (without F.C. & A.C.) in Shastri / +3 (Arts) level in aggregate is essential. Relaxation of 5% marks for S.C./ S.T. candidates is allowed.

2. **AGE:**The candidate must have to be completed minimum age limit of 20 years as on 01.08.2025.

3. **ENTRANCE TEST:**For admission in to the course candidate must have to qualify the entrance test.

4. **NUMBER OF SEATS:** 50 (FIFTY)

5. **RESERVATION OF SEATS**

- 20% of the total seats will be filled up with the SJSU students and other seats will be filled up by duly following Odisha Government reservation norms i.e. for SC / ST / PHC candidates.
- If reserved seats remain vacant for non-availability of suitable candidates of concerned group the seats may be allotted to the candidates of other category as the case may be.

6. **DURATION OF THE COURSE**

The duration of the course is Four Semesters. Each semester is consisting of 90 working days/ curriculum transaction day excluding admission and examination days. The 90 transaction days will include teaching practice and revision. A maximum of 05 days for leave may be considered in a semester.

7. **CRITERIA FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORM:**

- (i) Requisite qualifications as desired under point No.-1
- (ii) Candidates whose examination results are awaited may also apply. They will be considered if qualified subject to submitting proof of acquiring desired qualification at the time of counseling for the purpose.
- (iii) Eligible in-service person may also apply through proper channel with no objection certificate from the competent authority .

Rs.800/- (Rupees eight hundred) only through the University online payment gateway

11. SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORM

- i) Duly filled in application form along with necessary enclosures should be sent to **The Principal, ShikshaShastri-B.Ed, Shree Jagannath Sanskrit University, Shreevihar, Puri, Odisha, Pin-752003** only by Regd. / Speed Post within the due date.
- ii) In-service candidates are required to send an advance copy of no objection certificate so as to reach the mentioned addressee on or before the last date of receipt of application.

12. ENCLOSURES:

1. Self-attested copies of certificates & mark sheets of the qualifying examinations.
2. The documentary evidence in support of the reserved categories.
3. Three recent pass port size photographs duly attested. One should be pasted on application form, one on identity card, and one on the admit card.
4. Identity Card for SSET (duly filled in)
5. Admit Card for SSET (duly filled in)
6. Money receipt of online payment of Rs.800/- (Rupees eight hundred) only mentioning full name of the candidate on the back side of the money receipt.

13. REJECTION OF APPLICATION FORM

1. Incomplete and incorrect filled in or late received application form will be rejected.
2. Canvassing in any form will disqualify the candidate.
3. In case of detection of any wrong information will stand for rejection.

14. DURATION OF EXAMINATION : 2 hours

15. MODE OF EVALUATION :

The ShikshaShastri-B.Ed is a professional course for Sanskrit teachers. Therefore :

- Securing at least 35%(**18 marks out of 50 marks**) marks for SC & ST students and 40% (**20 marks out of 50 marks**) marks for others in Sanskrit Language proficiency i.e. Group- A.
- An aggregate of **53 marks for SC & ST students and 60 marks for others** in all groups will be qualified for SSET(Group 'A' to 'E').

16. DESIGN OF QUESTION PAPER OF SSET :

- The ShikshaShastri Entrance Test (SSET) will consist of question papers in the shape of Multiple Choice and the O.M.R Sheet will be provided for answer .
- **Full mark : 150**
- Each question contains one mark.
- While answering each question , darken only one of the four circles with Blue/Black Pen .

For each question, four choices of the answer shall be provided. Out of these only one will be the correct answer. If more than one answers are marked against any question, it will be treated as wrong and no mark will be awarded for such an answer. All the questions will be in Sanskrit language.

17. EXAMINATION CENTRE

The exact date, venue and other details for the Entrance Test will be communicated with the admit card and in University Website.

*There will be an examination centre in Western zone specially in Sambalpur.(If nos of students is less than 100 numbers, then Puri will be the centre of those students who applied for Sambalpur centre.

18. ADMIT CARD

The Admit Card will be uploaded in the University website on dated 16/06/2025. The candidates has to download the admit card and bring a printout of the same to the examination hall. He/she has to bring a proof of identity to the examination hall along with admit card.

19. DISQUALIFICATION FOR EXAMINATION (SSET)

- i) Candidates using unfair means getting external help or helping others or indulging in indiscipline in the test will be simply disqualified and the judicial action may also be initiated.
- ii) In case of mismatch of photo then the suspension from exam / cancellation of admission or any other legal action will be taken against the candidates. For any such inconvenience, the candidates will be himself / herself responsible
- iii) In spite of instruction given in the body of Admit Card if a candidate wishes to take mobile phones or any other communication devices inside the examination premises will be disqualified to appear at the examination.
- iv) Reaching at examination centre after scheduled time, without having Admit Card in the examination hall and showing misbehavior in the examination hall be debarred from appearing the Exam.

20 SELECTION FOR ADMISSION :

- i) The candidate must have to qualified the SSET, conducted by Shree Jagannath Sanskrit University, Shreevihar, Puri
- ii) Scrutiny of eligibility for admission, decision, regarding the quota, verification of reservation etc. are under the control of authority of SJSU, Puri.
- iii) The admission will be strictly on the basis of number of seats as recognized by NCTE.
- iv) In case of admission the decision of the concerned authority of the University shall be final and binding upon.
- v) At the time of admission the SSET Admit Card has to be submitted.
- vi) Out of merit-list prepared the categories of candidates will be ascertained and the admission procedure will be followed accordingly.

21. GENERAL RESERVATION

Out of the total number of seats, reservation as per rules of the Government of Odisha will be followed .

Competent Authorities for issuing the Certificates for Reserved Categories are as under:

- **Candidates belonging to SC / ST category :** District Magistrate / Sub-Divisional Magistrate / Tehsildar / Mandal Revenue Officer (M.R.O.)
- **Otherwise abled and blind :**Chief Medical Officer of Civil Hospital.
(Only 40% or more disability will be considered.)
- Children / Widows of Armed Forces personnel disabled / killed in the war / hostilities Secretary, Army / Navy / Air-force Board.
- **For Sportsmen :** (Participating at National / International level competitions)
- **For other Backward classes** - As per State Govt. rule

Candidates who belongs to any of the above reserved categories, should furnish a certificate of their category duly attested by a Gazetted Officer failing which the eligibility will be rejected. In case of non-availability of such candidates, the seats will be filled from the general category. Allotment of reservation of seats will be done at the State level only.

22.COURSE FEE:-Rs 20,000/- (Twenty thousand) only.

The student will deposit an amount **Rs.13,350/- (Rupees Thirteen Thousand Three Hundred Fifty)** only at the time of Admission and an amount **Rs.6,650/- (Rupees Six Thousand Six Hundred Fifty)** only at the time of re- admission in the secondyear in the shape of Demand Draft in favour of **Comptroller of Finance, S.J.S.U., Puri.**

23. IMPORTANT NOTE :

- i) Fee (except caution money) once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- ii) The relaxation mentioned in the regulations / instructions will be concurrent, that is, if a candidate is eligible for more than one category then only one of the relaxation of the highest permissible limit will be granted.
- iii) The authority of University reserves everyright to reject application without assigning any reason thereon.
- iv) Admission of candidates in all stages will be purely provisional subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions.
- v) The candidates should note that their admission to the entrance examination (SSET) will be purely provisional based on the information given by them in the application form. This will be subject to verification of all the eligibility conditions by theSJSV, PURI
- vi) Rank will be decided on the basis of merit.
- vii) All the legal matters will come under the jurisdiction at Puri.

24. SHIKSHASHASTRI ENTRANCE TEST 2025 – DATES AND TIMING

Shree Jagannath Sanskrit University, Shreevihar, Puri will conduct **SHIKSHASHASTRI-B.Ed.** Entrance test SSET-2025 for two years Shikshashastris- B.Edprogramme on **22nd June 2025** from **10: 00 A.M. to 12:00 Noon** at specified centres.
