SPECIAL RECRUITMENT (FOR SCHEDULED TRIBE CANDIDATES ONLY) FOR THE POST OF HOMOEOPATHIC MEDICAL OFFICER AND AYURVEDIC MEDICAL OFFICER

The Orissa Staff Selection Commission had conducted recruitment examination for the post of **Homoeopathic Medical Officer** vide its Advertisement No.36 dt.6.1.2003 and for the post of **Ayurvedic Medical Officer** vide Advertisement No.43 dt.6.1.2003. As adequate numbers of ST candidates were not available, 42 posts of HMO and 21 posts of AMO under ST category remained vacant. As desired by Govt. in Health & Family Welfare Department, a special recruitment is being undertaken to fill up the said vacant posts by ST candidates. Applications are therefore invited from eligible ST candidates in the format indicated below.

2. VACANCY POSITION:

NOTE: If adequate number of suitable women candidates of S.T.category are not available, suitable men candidates of S.T. category will be sponsored. Reservation for Ex-Service Men / Physically Handicapped / Sports persons shall be as per rules.

3. EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

For HMO:- Bachelor Degree in Homoeopathic Medicine & Surgery (BHMS) from any recognized University/

For AMO:- Bachelor Degree in Ayurvedic Medicine & Surgery (BAMS) from any recognized University.

4. PAY:

@Rs.7,000/- (Consolidated) per month on annual renewable contract basis.

5. AGE LIMIT:

The candidate shall not be less than 18 years and more than 37 years of age as on 1.1.2006 including relaxation of 5 years for S.T. category. The upper age limit is relax able by 10 years in case of Physically Handicapped candidates. The entire period of admissible service rendered in Armed Forces by an Ex-Serviceman will be relaxed as per Rules. Only one type of age relaxation can be availed of by a candidate.

6. ELIGIBILITY:

A candidate must (a) be a citizen of India, (b) be of good moral character, (c) be of sound health, good physique and free from any organic defect or bodily infirmity, (d) must not have more than one spouse living, (e) should have (i) passed M.E. School examination with Oriya as language subject or (ii) passed H.S.C. or equivalent examination with Oriya as medium of examination in non-language subjects or (iii) passed in Oriya as language subject in the final examination of Class-VII and above, or (iv) passed a test in Oriya in M.E. School standard conducted by the Education Department of the State Government.

7. PLAN OF EXAMINATION AND SELECTION PROCEDURE:

There shall be separate examination/selection for HMO & AMO as indicated below:

i) Written test comprising 2 papers of 100 marks each of 2 hours duration. The questions will be of objective type/short-answer type. Each paper shall consist of 50 questions for 50 marks of objective type and 10 questions for 50 marks of short answer type.	..	200
ii) Assessment of academic career from HSC up to Degree(BHMS/BAMS as applicable) (5 bonus marks will be awarded to candidates possessing PG degree from a recognized University)	..	60

Short-listing for viva-voce shall be made on the basis of aggregate marks secured by a candidate in the written examination and career assessment taken together. The number of candidates to be called for **viva-voce** test shall be about 3-times the number of vacancies in each category.

Final select-list shall be prepared on the basis of marks secured by candidates in the written test, career assessment and viva-voce test taken together.

B) For Ayurvedic Medical Officer (AMO):

PAPER-I

(1) Sharira Rachana, (2) Sharira Kriya, (3) Drabyaguna, (4) Rasashastra, (5) Swasthvrit, (6) Agadatantra & Vyavahar Ayurveda.

PAPER-II

(1) Rog Vijnan and Vikrit Vijnan, (2) Kayachikitsa, (3) Shalyatantra,(4) Prasutitantra & Stree Roga,(5) Kaumarbritya and (6) Shalkyatantra.

9. EXAMINATION FEES:

There shall be no such fee.

10. EXAMINATION CENTRE:

The venue(s) for written examination will be decided by the Commission and will be intimated to the candidates in due course.

11. DOCUMENTS TO BE ATTACHED TO APPLICATION:

Attested true copies of the following documents must be attached to the application form:

- (a) Caste Certificate from competent authority for employment purposes.
- (b) Pass certificate of HSC or equivalent Examination in support of date of birth/age.
- (c) Certificate in support of passing degree (BHMS/BAMS) examination and P.G. Degree, if any.
- (d) Mark sheets and certificates of all examinations passed starting from HSC or equivalent examination onwards.
- (e) Certificate in support of passing Oriya in M.E. level, wherever applicable.
- (f) Four copies of recent passport size photograph of the candidate duly signed in full by him / her and attested by a Gazetted Officer on the front, one of which should be affixed in the space provided at the top right hand corner of the application form and three securely attached to the application form.
- (g) A self addressed post card with postage stamp of Rs5.50 for sending index number.
- (h) A self addressed envelope of 22 cm .X 10 cm.size affixed with postal stamp of Rs.5/-for despatch of admission letter.
- (i) Candidate claiming to be Ex-Serviceman must enclose attested true copies of certificates from the competent authority about length of service rendered.
- (j) Candidates belong to Physically handicapped./ Sportsman category must enclose attested xerox copies of their valid identity card issued by the competent authority.

NOTE: Original certificates should not be enclosed to the application form. All the documents are to be attested both by a gazetted officer and also by the candidate himself/herself.

12. SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION:

Candidates are required to apply on foolscap paper in the prescribed format.
