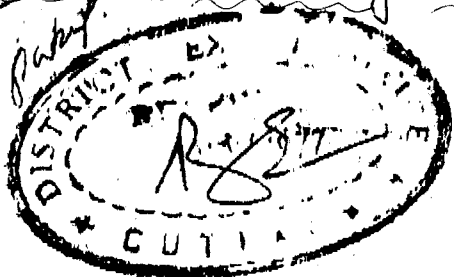

Sub:- Settlement of retail Foreign Liquor Shops for
the year, 1977-78.

Sir,

I am directed to say that there is no statutory rule regarding grant of Foreign Liquor 'off' licences. The Foreign liquor 'off' licences are granted according to the executive instructions issued by the Board of Revenue. But there is no provision in the Board's order that filing of application by an intending person is binding on such person to take the licence, if selected.

In order to avoid such contingencies in future, it has now been ordered by the Excise Commissioner that hence forwarded a clause in the notice inviting applications from the intending persons for grant of foreign liquor licences may be added to the effect that every intending applicant should deposit a sum of Rs. 2,000/- as security in form of Bank Draft or other kinds of security pledged to the Collector of the District. The security so deposited will be returned to the person not selected and shall be liable to be forfeited if a selected applicant declines to take the licence and run the ~~shop~~ shop.
