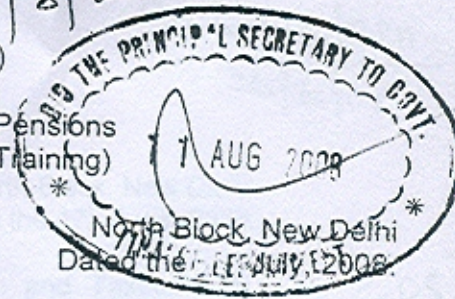

2. The programme has been designed to meet the demand for the qualified specialists in the area of tax policy and administration in developing countries. The concentration areas will be - Business Economics, Japanese Economy, Domestic Tax Law, International Tax Law, International Economy, Accounting, Advanced Study of Public Finance, Advanced Study of Finance, Advanced Study of Tax Administration, Basic Business History, Academic Writing, Business Communication, Introduction to Econometrics, Advanced Study of International Relations, Advanced Study of International Finance, Advanced Study of International Economic Policy and Money and Banking.

3. The scholarship covers tuition fee, living expenses and round-trip air fare between Japan and the home country of the candidate. However, if a student fails to obtain the Masters Degree within the scholarship period of 2 years, return air fare will not be provided to him. The applicant should hold a bachelor's degree or equivalent in commerce, economics, law or a similar discipline with distinguished academic record, should have at least four years of recent full-time professional experience in the field of tax policy and administration. The candidate should be between the age of 25 and 45, be in good health both physically and mentally and not be serving in the military. He should be competent in spoken and written English.

4. The nomination details should be submitted on the prescribed application form duly authenticated by the Department concerned. The application form should be routed through the concerned Ministry/Department/State Government/UT. The application form of the eligible candidates should reach to this Department latest by 12th September, 2008. Applications received after the prescribed date will not be considered.

2. The applicant should hold a bachelor's degree or its equivalent for its development-related field and have at least 4 years recent full-time professional experience in a field related to economic development or public policy, in the applicant's home country or in another developing country. He should be between the age of 24 and 45; be nationals of a world bank borrowing country; be mid-career professionals in public service; be of good character, a team player and active in extracurricular activities. The candidates should be competent in spoken and written English. The candidates who currently pursuing a Master's or Ph.D. programme in industrialized countries; who have had one or more years of training/studies and/or residency in an industrialized country; permanent residents/ nationals of industrialized countries; Executive Directors, their alternates and staff of the World Bank Group as well as their close relatives, are not eligible for the degree programme.

4. The objective of the programme is to develop a basic understanding of public policy and taxation; to teach the concept and methods of an entire taxation process through an internship programme and to offer specialized courses of study on various aspects of public policy and taxation. The programme covers a monthly allowance of JPY 1,70,000 and a round-trip air ticket to Japan plus a travel allowance of JPY 60,000. The monthly stipend is intended to cover living, commuting and other incidental expenses during the study period. In addition, the scholarship covers tuition, entrance examination and admission fees. Travel expenses for some programme-sponsored field trips are also included

5. The nomination details should be submitted in the University's prescribed application form-2008 along with other requisite performae, duly authenticated by the organization of the candidate and routing through the Ministry/Deptt. Concerned. It should be certified by the competent authority that the organization is a Government Institution.

6. The applications of the eligible candidates should reach this Department latest by 22nd September, 2008. The applications received after the prescribed date, will not be considered.
