As you are aware, under the existing scheme of in-service training programmes for IAS Officers, all eligible IAS Officers are expected to attend a 1-week in-service training programme, once in a block of two years. Under the current block of year 2008-2010, the year 2009-2010 is the second year of this block which is commencing from April, 2009. It may also kindly be noted that the 2-week training programmes have been replaced by the Mid-Career Training (MCT) programmes for IAS Officers, which they are required to attend at specified stages of their career.

2. The IAS Officers from 1979 to 1999 batches are eligible to attend the one-week in-service training programme this year.

3. I enclose herewith, the calendar of the one-week in-service training programmes available for the year 2009-2010. I request that the training calendar may be circulated to all the eligible IAS Officers in your State.

4. It is also requested that the officers may be encouraged to opt for those training programmes which are relevant to their current jobs as well as the kind of assignments they are likely to hold in future. The Officers giving their option for the particular training programme may kindly be nominated accordingly. The State Government may also scrutinize the options exercised by officers for a particular training programme before recommended/nominating them for a particular course.

5. While nominating these officers in the training programmes, the complete address with ID Number of the Officer, telephone number, fax number and e-mail address must be given. The list of nominated officers may kindly be sent to this Department or to Shri P.K. Subnani, Senior Research Officer, **E-mail ID subnani.pk@nic.in** well in advance before the commencement of the training programme.

6. I solicit your kind cooperation for the successful conduct of the training programmes, by enabling wide publicity of the programmes amongst the IAS Officers and by facilitating the attendance of a large number of officers in these programmes.
