

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE MEETING OF HIGH POWER COMMITTEE  
CONSTITUTED VIDE GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION NO. 15641/HE DATED  
01.05.2004 HELD ON 27.06.2009 AT 11.00 A.M. IN THE OFFICE CHAMBER OF  
COMMISSIONER-CUM-SECRETARY TO GOVERNMENT, DEPARTMENT  
OF HIGHER EDUCATION**

1. The meeting of the High Power Committee constituted vide Government Notification No.15641/HE dated 01.05.2004 was held under the Chairmanship of Commissioner-cum-Secretary, Department of Higher Education in his office chamber to consider the proposals for grant of permission/recognition in respect of general/professional colleges under Section-5 and 6 of the Orissa Education Act, 1969. The Special Secretary to Government in Higher Education Department attended this Committee meeting as a Special invitee as per the desire of the Chairman.

The Commissioner-cum-Secretary to Government, Department of Higher Education and the Chairperson of the Committee while initiating discussion indicated that altogether 178 proposals for grant of permission/recognition in respect of General and Professional Colleges were placed before the committee for consideration. After detailed discussion following decisions were taken.

**2. Opening of New +2/+3 Colleges:**

All together 09 proposals were received from Regional Directors of Education in respect of +2 Colleges. The Committee after detailed discussion decided to allow only 07 cases and 02 proposals were rejected. The list of cases allowed/rejected is placed at **Annexure-A**.

This opening permission is granted, subject to the condition that the educational agencies shall pledge an amount of Rs.5.00 lakhs in favour of the prescribed authority and a further amount of Rs.20.00 lakhs shall be shown either in shape of Bank deposit standing in the name of the college or infrastructural development such as land, building, furniture and fixtures of Rs.20.00 lakhs or above within a period of one month, failing which the educational agency shall not be permitted to admit students. The condition cannot be relaxed by Director, Higher Education and Regional Directors of Education under any circumstance. Further Secretary of the Governing Body must furnish an undertaking in the form of an affidavit that they will not claim any financial assistance or grant-in-aid from Government in future.

The Regional Directors of Education are requested to put the following conditions strictly as per decision of High Power Committee Meeting dated 28.03.2007 in their permission letter to be issued to college concerned.

- i) That, the college should acquire required land (2 Acres in Urban area /5 Acres in Rural area) in its name within the first two years failing which temporary recognition beyond two years shall not be granted.
- ii) That, the college shall start construction of required building (Class room, Laboratory, Library etc.) by 4th year and its progress should be verified while allowing temporary recognition. The progress of civil construction should be at least as follows:-

By 4<sup>th</sup> year – 25%

By 5<sup>th</sup> Year – 50%

By 6<sup>th</sup> Year – 75%

By 7<sup>th</sup> Year – 100%

**3. Opening of New Stream in +2/+3 Colleges:**

The Department had received 54 proposals for opening of new stream in respect of +2 and +3 colleges. The committee after detailed discussion allowed 40 cases, 13 cases were rejected and rest 01 case was deferred. The list of cases allowed/rejected/deferred is placed at **Annexure-B.**

The decision of H.P.C. meeting held on 04.06.2009, 05.06.2009 & 06.06.2009 for opening of +2 Science stream with 32 seats from the session 2009-10 in respect of Radhaballav Mahavidyalaya, Bairipur, Puri is modified and opening of +2 Science with 64 seats (PCMB) from the session 2009-10 is allowed.

**4. Increase of Seats:**

The Department had received 31 proposals for grant of permission to increase seats in respect of +2 and +3 colleges. After detailed discussion, the committee allowed 26 cases and 05 proposals were rejected. The list of cases allowed/rejected is placed at **Annexure-C.**

The decision of H.P.C. meeting held on 04.06.2009, 05.06.2009 & 06.06.2009 for increase of seats from 128 to 160 in +2 Arts from the session 2009-10 in respect of Radhaballav Mahavidyalaya, Bairipur, Puri is modified and increase of seats from 128 to 192 in +2 Arts from the session 2009-10 is allowed.

**5. Grant of Permanent Recognition to +2/+3 Colleges:**

The Department had received 19 proposals for grant of permanent recognition in respect of +2 and +3 colleges. The committee after discussion decided to allow permanent recognition to all subjects of +3 wing of S.V.M. (Auto) College, Jagatsinghpur and Banki (Auto) College, Banki from the session 2006-07 in view of the Autonomous status declared during 2006-07. Other proposals were deferred due to shortage of time.

**6. Grant of Temporary Recognition to +2/+3 Colleges:**

The Department had received 15 proposals for grant of temporary recognition in respect of +2 and +3 colleges. After detailed discussion the committee allowed first temporary recognition to Hons. in Computer Science with 32 seats in +3 Science for the session 2008-09 in favour of Jawaharlal College, Patnagarh, Bolangir in view of appearance of students in the ensuing University Examination. The proposal for grant of temporary recognition to Vidya Science College, Berhampur, Ganjam for the session 2007-08 and 2008-09 was discussed in pursuance with the order dated 24.03.2009 of Hon'ble High

Court passed in W.P.(C) No.1953/09. After discussion it was decided to instruct Regional Director of Education, Berhampur to submit parawise report on the petition submitted by the E.A. and place the same in the High Power Committee meeting for taking final decision in the matter. Similarly the proposal for grant of temporary recognition to +2 Science with 96 seats for the session 2007-08 and 2008-09 in favour of Pratik Science College, Sambalpur was accorded pursuant to the order dated 19.05.2009 of Hon'ble High Court passed in Misc. Case No.5729/2009, arising out of W.P.(C) No.3250/2009. The college is to be closed and no further admission is allowed from the session 2009-10.

Other proposals were deferred due to shortage of time.

**7. Opening of New Subjects:**

Proposal for opening of new subject in 07 (+2 and +3) colleges were received from Regional Directors of Education for consideration. After detailed discussion the committee allowed all 07 cases. The list of cases allowed is placed at **Annexure-D**.

**8. Opening of Honours Subjects:**

All together 11 proposals for opening of Hons. subjects in +3 colleges were received from Regional Directors of Education for consideration. After detailed discussion held in this regard the committee decided to allow 10 cases and one case was rejected. The list of cases allowed/rejected is placed at **Annexure-E**.

**9. Grant of Permission and Recognition to Sanskrit Colleges:**

All together 04 cases in respect of Sanskrit Colleges were discussed by the Committee. After detailed discussion, the committee allowed 03 cases and one proposal was rejected. The list of cases which is allowed/rejected is placed at **Annexure-F**.

**10. Professional Colleges:**

Altogether 26 proposals were received from Director, Higher Education in respect of Private Professional Colleges. Out of 26 proposals, 14 proposals are relating to opening permission and rest 12 proposals are relating to temporary & permanent recognition. After detailed discussion the committee decided to allow 08 cases and 06 cases were rejected in respect of opening permission. The list of cases allowed/rejected in respect of opening permission is placed at **Annexure-G**. The case of Mahaveer College, Bhadrak was considered with reference to the petition by the Principal and the decision of the H.P.C. dated 10.02.2009 granting opening permission for BCA with 30 seats were

modified by increasing the BCA seats to 60 and allowing opening permission for BBA course with 30 seats in view of the GO (iii) of para-11. Similarly the committee decided to allow 08 cases, 02 cases were deferred and rest 02 cases were rejected in respect of temporary & permanent recognition. The list of cases allowed/deferred/rejected in respect of temporary & permanent recognition is placed at **Annexure-H**.

This opening permission is granted, subject to the condition that the educational agencies shall pledge an amount of Rs.10.00 lakhs in favour of the prescribed authority and a further amount of Rs.30.00 lakhs shall be shown either in shape of Bank deposit standing in the name of the college or infrastructural documents such as land, building, furniture and fixtures worth Rs.30.00 lakhs or above within a period of one month, failing which the educational agency shall not be permitted to admit students. The condition cannot be relaxed by Director, Higher Education under any circumstance. Further Secretary of the Governing Body must furnish an undertaking in the form of an affidavit that they will not claim any financial assistance or grant-in-aid from Government in future.

The Director, Higher Education is requested to put the following conditions strictly as per decision of High Power Committee Meeting dated 28.03.2007 in their permission letter to be issued to college concerned.

- i) That, the college should acquire required land (2 Acres in Urban area / 5 Acres in Rural area) in its name within the first two years failing which temporary recognition beyond two years shall not be granted.
- ii) That, the college shall start construction of required building (Class room, Laboratory, Library etc.) by 4th year and its progress should be verified while allowing temporary recognition. The progress of civil construction should be at least as follows:-

By 4<sup>th</sup> year – 25%  
 By 5<sup>th</sup> Year – 50%  
 By 6<sup>th</sup> Year – 75%  
 By 7<sup>th</sup> Year – 100%

**11. General Observation (GOs):**

The following two general observations (at Sl. xiii and Sl. xiv) are made by the committee in addition to the twelve general observations already made earlier (Sl. i to Sl. xii).

- i) Proposals for increase of seats or opening of new stream can only be considered after appearance of at least one batch of students.
- ii) Any new teacher/non-teaching staff required for managing/teaching the students on account of increase of seats be funded out of self financing route. The honorarium/remuneration of these teachers should be at par with other teachers in the college. The college management should give an undertaking and affidavit before taking new students. The H.P.C. observed that this should be followed strictly in view of the restrictions of the Finance Department on account of new appointments.
- iii) The qualification of I.T. lecturers and Computer Science lecturers shall be MCA and B.E. in I.T. or B.E. in Computer Science or MSc (Comp. Science).
- iv) Regarding grant of Temporary Recognition (TR) for back periods, HPC had earlier decided to keep the period as such. This is creating problem for the institutions regarding continuity in Recognition. Therefore, the HPC felt it necessary to reverse the earlier decision and allow TR for back periods.
- v) The college/institution has to produce a certificate from Tahasildar regarding location of land and building owned by the college authority for Permanent recognition.
- vi) Permanent recognition would be given in 2-3 years i.e. after passing of one batch of students, if the college fulfills the necessary conditions as provided in the Orissa Education Act, 1969.
- vii) Any permission for opening of new colleges, increase of seats, opening of new stream, opening of new subject and opening of Hons. subjects will be considered by May every year. Similarly for of grant of recognition (temporary/ permanent), the colleges/institutions have to apply by the end of August every year which is to be considered in the month of September/October. Thus there would be two phase of HPC in a year, one for Opening Permission and the second for grant of Recognition.
- viii) Five subjects are to be allowed for +3 colleges having 64 seats instead of 4 subjects.

- ix) For opening of new subjects/new streams due to restrictions by Finance Department, no new faculty can be recruited by the management. They can run it under self-financing mode like I.T. or Computer Science only. If any college is willing to abide by this condition, it can open a new subject/new stream.
- x) Sanskrit as an 'Elective' subject in +2 Science seems to have been included in 2007 vide notification No. 14019/HE dt. 01.03.2007. As the matter is under reconsideration of Government, all matters relating to any college opting for 'Sanskrit' as an Elective subject under +2 Science stream is to be deferred till a decision in the matter is taken by the Government.
- xi) Separation of laboratory between Junior and Degree College is necessary. Similarly improvement of Science laboratory for opening of Honours subject is essential and has to be certified before grant of FTR for any new Honours subject.
- xii) At present, there are 35 Self-Financing +2 Science Junior Colleges functioning in the Municipal limits of Bhubaneswar. It was reported that there are applications for starting 25 more +2 (Junior) Residential Science Colleges in and around Bhubaneswar. As there are a large no. of vacant seats in existing Residential Colleges and as starting of 25 new Colleges would require a large number of trained teachers/Lecturers, the committee felt that giving opening permission to such large number of Junior Science Colleges would not be in the interest of education. Secondly, there seems to be no felt need to start so many new Junior Colleges in the Capital City when feeder High Schools are limited.
- xiii) The HPC observes that in the interest of students and their future, the colleges should have separate land recorded in their name as per provisions of O.E. Act, 1969. Some colleges are taking the plea that the Educational Agency (EA) has got the land but it is seen that the same EA is operating more than one educational institute over the same plot of land. So for the interest of the students one year time is allowed (till 30.06.2010) to all EAs to record separate land in the name of the college/institution failing which no further recognition shall be allowed to the EA. The concerned EA should file an affidavit before the PA to that effect after which conditional recognition shall be accorded these colleges/institutions.

xiv) It is decided to accord permission to professional colleges either with minimum permission of 60 seats if one course is permitted to open or with minimum of 30 seats each if two courses are permitted to open to make the colleges viable.

**12. Permission for Admission of Students in Self-financing +2 Science Colleges:**

The four colleges as per **Annexure-I** whose admission was restricted for the session 2009-10 in earlier H.P.C. was taken up for discussion. After threadbare discussion it has been decided to permit these colleges for admission of students subject to condition as observed in G.O.- (xiii) of para-11 above. The same GO is also to be made applicable to similarly situated Professional college like DAV Business School, Unit-8, Bhubaneswar.

**13.** It was decided that HPC should publish the relevant portions of Education Act, 1969 and decisions of HPC in shape of a booklet and make it available to intending Education Agencies/Non-Government Colleges at a reasonable cost. This may be done by 31.08.2009.

**14.** It was noted by HPC that Sri Jagannath Sanskrit University (SJSU), Puri should ask the Upasastri Colleges (+2) for **Return of Matriculates** in similar line as is being done by Council (CHSE). This should be submitted by all Upasastri colleges by 31<sup>st</sup> December of the Academic Year in which students take admission. It should start for 2009-10 Admission Session. Sri Jagannath Sanskrit University my implement it immediately this year.
