Sub: Holding of 'Mo Jami-Mo Diha' Mela in Tahsils- Collaboration with credible local Non-Governmental Organisations.

Sir,

I am desired to invite reference to the Letter No. 34502/R&DM Dt. 28.8.2008 and No. 34284/CS(R&DM) Dated. 12.8.2008 of the Chief Secretary and Chief Development Commissioner on the subject.

You were requested to launch 'Mo Jami-Mo Diha' campaign in Tahsils in order to confirm and protect the land rights of the deprived sections who were granted lease of Government land through initiation of suo-motu cases basing on records as well as inviting grievance petitions/applications. But as will be seen, the desired target has not yet been achieved and in some Tahsils, the campaign is still in progress. Since the campaign is scheduled to end on 31st December, 2008, it has been decided to organize at least one Mo Jami-Mo Diha Mela in each Tahsil during November/December, 2008 and involve the local N.G.Os to accelerate the campaign. You may decide N.G.Os who can help to locate the beneficiaries deprived of their right, title and possession of lease by the vested interests and assist them to file petitions with Tahsildar for redressal of their grievances.

You are, therefore, requested to intimate the NGOs of proven track record, operating in your jurisdiction to help in the process of informing the beneficiaries with regard to date and location of the 'Mo Jami Mo Diha Mela' and help them to appear and file applications/petitions.

You are requested to report action in this regard.
