Sub : Heat Wave Preparedness for Summer-2010.


Sir,

I am directed to say that Government have decided to take following precautionary and preparatory measures in all-educational institutions including public schools and privately managed schools to mitigate possible heat wave during Summer-2010.

1. Timing of all Classes be rescheduled between 6.30 AM to 10.30 AM in all Schools of the State (including public schools and privately managed schools) from **15th March, 2010**.
2. All school examinations in the State (including those conducted by public schools and privately managed schools) should be completed by 30th April 2010 and the timing of the examination will be between 6.30 AM to 10.30 AM. **However this instruction will not be applicable to the H.S.C. Examination – 2010 and other examination conducted by the BSE, Orissa which will be held as per schedule.**
3. The schools which adopt two shifts will manage in the following manner (a) **1st shift : 6.30 AM to 8.30 AM** (b) **2nd shift : 8.30 AM to 10.30 AM.**
4. Headmasters should be instructed to make provision for drinking water in the schools where tube wells are not available.
5. Headmasters should advise the students to come to the school with umbrella and water bottles during the summer season.
6. Physical training in the school should be made optional for the students till the heat wave is reduced.
7. Summer vacation will begin with effect from 01.05.2010.


You are requested to take suitable action at your level for combating the heat wave situation during summer, 2010. Action taken by you may please be intimated immediately to this Department.




